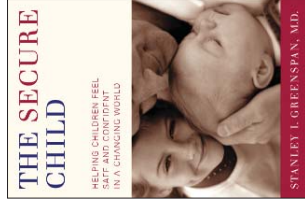


Great Kids

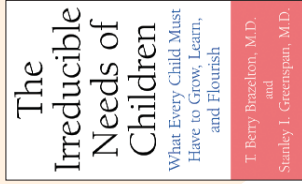

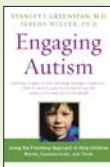

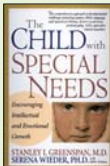
