Cutting-edge new material. This edition has been thoroughly updated to address important new topics, including teletechnologies, masculinities, bare life, and more.

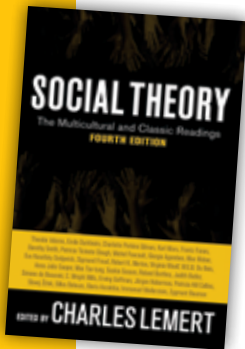
