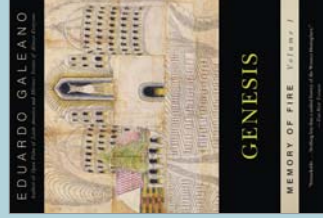

Memory of Fire Three-Volume Series

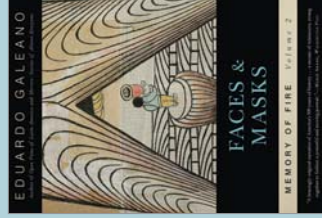
Eduardo Galeano's *Memory of Fire* series is a sweeping interpretation of the Americas no work of history has previously imagined

Genesis is both a meditation on the clashes between the Old World and the New and, in the author's words, an attempt to "rescue the kidnapped memory of all America."

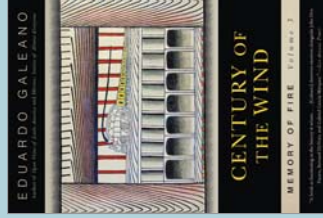

Volume 3: Century of the Wind

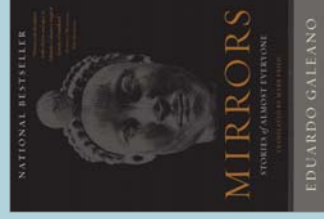

Mirrors Stories of Almost Everyone

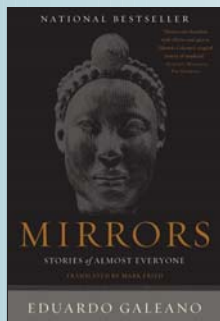
